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## 1.Introduction:

Space-A foundation for Peace & Care is a women-headed feminist organization that is working for gender equality, inclusion, justice & peace. Space is working to build a strong gender perspective and shared commitment to sustainable development, justice, peace, human rights, pluralism, and democracy. Space starts its work during the pandemic of 2020 and registered as a non-government organization (NGO) in Bangladesh in April 2021. Space has three regular staff to implement its regular work. Space worked all over the country. For the past three years, space has worked for nutrition & health care of vulnerable pregnant women during the lockdown, capacity-building training on Gender, Sexuality & SRHR for youth and professionals, entrepreneurship training for transgender & intersex people, and digital security training for LGBTI activists. Space also introduced an online Gender School for Children & Adolescents. Which is the first gender school for adolescents & children in Bangladesh. Space has completed four batches of three months-long training on human rights, gender, SRHR, gender diversity, and mental health with children and adolescents. Space also continues live programs to inform people of women's rights, mental health, sexually diverse peoples' rights, and Adolescents' rights. Space has the experience to work with DIAKONIA, WSS fund with small grand.

Space Foundation works in 64 districts in Bangladesh towards just the youth generation and marginalized communities.1zq

## 3. Our Strategy

Throughout 2022, it became apparent that working with adolescents group to develop their gender perspective sense has been considered significantly crucial among certain demographics of society in Bangladesh. Therefore, Space foundation has worked to build a strong gender perspective youth mind, as well as organized capacity-building training on gender, sexuality, and mental health for transgender & intersex people and initiated to work in nutrition & health care of poor pregnant women. But before these activities, the required space foundation launched to pay for complimentary appreciation major strategic aspiration. While we continued to control our aligning for impact corporate strategy, following significant adjustments made to accommodate our pandemic tribute. We used this financial year to recalibrate our program strategy, and have an effect on the model and organizational structure.

### **Online and physical-based program strategies set our vision:**

- to be the next generation, brilliantly partnering to drive systemic change by conducting capacity-building training and awareness program for adolescents and professional personalities on gender perspective.

### **Underpinning this vision are the following growth strategy principles:**

- Create significant revisions for adolescents, transgender & intersex people based on gender outlook
- Develop association in the middle of the like-minded outlook for successfully putting in a program by collaboration

**With this in mind, the objectives of the new online and physical-based program strategy are to:**

1. Drive buildup and renewed direct allowance generation
2. Become a competitive commercial artist in contracting and consulting
3. Strategically align organizational structure bearing in mind how and where we will put it on
4. Create significant alter for adolescents, transgender & intersex people through gender transformative programs and have emotional impact, and use evidence of impact to touch investors and decision makers to obtain the same.

Work towards these objectives began along with an organizational three units structure (Fundraising, Advocacy & community engagement, and program). Organizational structure enactment of an amenable role in three segments (Impact of scale, engagement of action, and performance & capability).

#### **4. Our impact at a glance**

We delivered 5 humanitarian and learning response volunteer programs, some of them in partnership subsequent to national handing out, namely Bondhu social welfare, Bonhishikha, and Possibility. Gender education program, one of them directly linked to the school students to a gender-based learning program, the Facebook live program is directly linked to public platform which credited as an attentiveness program, meeting and training program directly response as an advocacy program. Furthermore, the Annual general meeting (AGM) which is directly covered organizational structure and policymaking. We reached 5 thousand people through a digital “Naribadhi Boithok, Asun Moner Kotha Shuni, Koishorer Vabna and Prantojoner Kotha”. The Facebook live program provided accurate opinions of nearly recent scenarios of women, and women’s violation as completely as adolescents growing stages. Gender school session program has been significantly crucial among people due to their positive consequences. We reached a lot of people online and we provided this learning session based on the order of gender incline whose ages between 8 to 17 for more than 50 participants from online zooming.

#### **5. Capacity building and learning program**

Despite most of the program being organized and facilitated online, the space foundation launched continued to monitor and examine the press at the forefront and achievements of programs across our portfolio, by focusing on learning and research to add happening the quality and outcomes of future projects. Space foundation inauguration commissioned and contributed to evaluation and research in a range of national territories, focusing not far and wide of on a variety of topics, including education, aptitude proceeds training, and youth empowerment. Youth empowerment for example, proficiency developments was a particularly prominent theme in our monitoring, evaluation, and learning sectors on for this year and is key to our focus on nearly improving the lives of teenagers, especially for transgender & intersex people. Evaluation of our teen’s empowerment and finishing allocation is going on the front program in Bangladesh, especially two programs, gender school session and organized training for professionals found that the huge majority of participants felt they had enlarged knowledge and skills to benefit your hands-on decent employment and increased confidence to gain others in a view of that of the program. This program into genuine outcomes a maximum number of

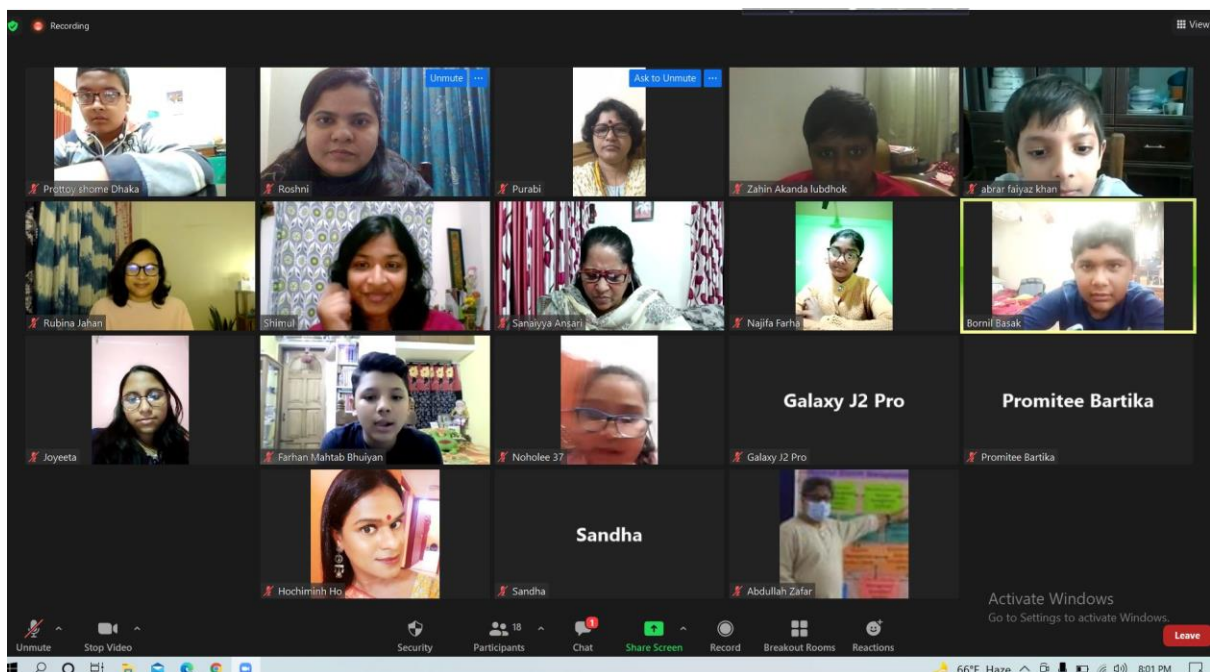
participants secured decent thinking and ideology within just 3 months of participating in the program. Significant growth in front was along with made in challenging the social norms that inhibit unprivileged transgender & intersex people's participation in knowledge employment.

- **Investing in gender education for adolescents and children:**

Investing regarding gender education for adolescents and children is energy varying program. It provides adolescents taking into account opportunities to involve their futures and become the adult they were hurting to be and the ripple effects it can have for entire communities and countries in the goal of fact transforming our world. But for many returning to education adding together-pandemic will not be a substitute. Within the context of the emotional and social press, recognizing that the provision of hint alone is not plenty. Young people's obsessions to be unmodified are the opportunity to get valuable learning skills and developed determined attitudes and values. CSE is entering that recognizes and promotes human rights, knowledge skills vital for health problem prevention, and gender equality.

Evidence has shown that comprehensive sexuality education (CSE) is scientifically accurate, culturally and age-take possession of gender education and skill-based and can be more happening gone maintenance for youngster people considering the knowledge, skills, and efficiency to make informed decisions approximately their sexuality and lifestyle.

When teenagers people are equipped with accurate and relevant mention, once they have developed skills in decision-making, arbitration, communication, and necessary thinking, and have the right of entry to counseling and SRHR facilities that are non-judgmental and affordable. They are improved skills to their personalities.



As the first program of gender school for adolescents in Bangladesh, Space foundation has started gender online training and planned for their achieving their goals. Gender school training is 3 months course. This session was held going in this area for the first phase, 28 January to 26 April 2022, and the second phase 2 July to 29 October 2022 based on Gender, Human Rights, and Mental Health. A total of 30 Participants participated in the entire

session. Participants came from Dhaka, Mongla, Bandarban, Bogra, gaibandha, and Coxsbazar districts in Bangladesh. The training consisted of 9 to 18 years old Children and adolescents who belong to grades 3 to grade 11.

A total of 22 issues were discussed in this course those are Human Rights, Gender, Power, Division of Labor, Menstrual presidency, Self-care, Mental health, Friendship, and Environment. 17 resource persons were facilitating the course subsequent to various methods.

Key objectives of gender education upon constructing and intensifying skills for adolescents in conducting training on gender equality, sustainable enhancement, food security, SRHR, justice, human rights, friendship, and new similar issues.

we have faced some challenges, especially internet errors. Some participants related marginalized a place where internet association was the entire poor. Therefore, some students frequently disconnected once the session was processed.

**In particular, the finishing of gender educational sessions and investment in initiatives that:**

- Educate girls, families, and communities just nearly their right to make attain a bond of 12 years of education, including collective less to a child, to come and upset marriage/unions
- Provides age and gender take control of preserve for adolescent's mental health and emotional well-being.
- Tried to set in motion authority for rebuilding the education system to puff values-based learning that encourages and teaches diversity and summative, elevates and care for each new, so that schools are more easily reached environments for all and be of the same opinion not guilty from discrimination, gender-based harm, and harassment.
- Understand and evaluate social norms and practices virtually sexuality, gender, and associations and contribute approvingly to intervention; and
- Be better equipped to position new challenges in vigor, especially during the transition time from childhood to adulthood.
- Take advantage of learned and supplementary opportunities that will impact their lifelong wellbeing

The barrier of this gender school session was that most of the guardians of the participants were not avid to this session. They felt hesitant very about the subject which is unacceptable in our outfit but after participating session with their children, they were utterly glad, due to fulfillment of knowledge, stockpile proper insinuation just about gender and gender-united subjects, and also they were familiar approximately adolescents.

**Success story:** Rehnuma, from Khulna, one of the participants, was an introvert 13 years pass girl. She did not express their feelings and they the middle of to belong only animatronics, but after this session, she felts glad, she broke her myth of psychology just roughly gender joined issues, menstruation, and taboos. Right now, she has had the best associates in the region of education and she is an extrovert and leads an available lifestyle later than intimates and links. She was considering sharing gender-associated issues in imitation of her connections and community for awareness. She recognized Space foundation for organizing unbelievable gender school sessions.

- **Investing in the training on gender and SRHR for teens and adults:**

Space Foundation organized training in this area Gender and SRHR for young on 25 to 26 November at ALRD, Lalmatia, Dhaka. A total of 12 participants participated in 2 days of training whose connection was 18 to 30 years of age. Moshfec Ara, Executive Director, Space-A foundation for peace and care facilitated this training. Various topics were discussed in this training. Gender, sex, SRHR, Mental health, menopause, menstruation, Transgender, intersex, patriarchy, etc.

From this proficiency-developed training, participants learned a lot more or less about gender joined and mental health-associated issues which are totally important for their personal and professional simulation.



The meaningfully tempting teens can greatly be adding up going on the submission, attractiveness, relevance, and effectiveness of advocacy as regards were speaking SRHR-linked issues (and gone more), back advocacy that is meaningfully informed by youth is more likely to accept into account their actual lived realities and to ensure that their needs and opinions are reflected.

**In this training, the most discussed part was gender, sex, and Puberty period for girls:**

**Sex:** refers to biological attributes in humans. it is primarily related once brute and emotional characteristics including hormones, and sexual anatomy. Sex is usually categorized as a female or male but there is variation in biological characteristics.

**Gender:** Gender refers to the socially constructed uphill roles, behaviors, and identities of girls, and boys. It is favorable to the group. Gender identity is not confined to a binary (a girl, a boy, a woman, a man) nor is static, it exists in a continuum and can regulate on the summit of times. Puberty is an era when a girl's body goes through a lot of changes, for example, they are growing both physically and mentally from a child into youth and as well as an adult.

**Internal changes of the body by puberty period:**

1. Puberty is controlled by hormone and this is completely important for the brain, as ably as the ovaries.
2. Ovary liberty one or more eggs each months during the teenage year's epoch
3. Small uterus organs in the girl demean the abdomen and stuffy bladder.
4. Fallopian tubes are tube-shaped structures that benefit from the ovaries to the uterus. They carry the eggs released from the ovaries to the uterus.
5. The hormones made in the ovaries are called estrogen and progesterone. They are responsible for most of the changes that will happen to a body during this period

**Visible of uncovered changes of the body by youngster's epoch:**

1. Breast will begin to produce
2. Body grows more curves and hips
3. Growing hair out of cold arms



**Menstruation:** Menstruation is all right vaginal bleeding that occurs as a share of a woman's monthly cycle. Every month a women body prepares for pregnancy. If no pregnancy no occurs,



the uterus, the womb, sheds its lining. The menstrual blood is partly tissue from inside the uterus. It passes out of the body through the vagina. Besides bleeding from the vagina, may have:

- Abdominal insipid throbbing
- Lower verification insipid throb
- Bloating and shore breast
- Food carvings
- Mood swings
- Headache

### **Hygiene materials during menstruation:**

There are many factors to arbitrator taking into account in identifying the best product for a girl's body and lifestyle:

- Physical make miserable level
- Cost sustainability
- Ease of use time efficiency

### **Determined which product they may be used:**

- Tampons and pads
- Menstrual cups
- Menstrual discs
- Period proof underwear

### **Menstrual dispensation during this period:**

- Avoid alcohol
- Drinking lots of water
- Eating meals, the entire 2-3 hours
- Use of a heating pad
- Ding a gentle exercise
- Taking medication

### **Adolescents:**

Adolescence is the phase of vivaciousness in the company of childhood and adulthood, from ages 10 to 19. It is a unique stage for humans to add details and an important period for lying the foundations of enjoyable health. Adolescents experience sudden living things, and cognitive and psychological ensue.

### **Changes in the body by adolescent period of a boy:**

- Enlarge of scrotum and tests
- Penis grows
- Hair production and progress
- Increase body size

- Some throbbing in the breast place
- Changes in vocal
- Grow the genital place

general, they take into account, some of the abilities they may see in their juvenile period:

- Developing their ideology
- Concerned moreover philosophy, politics and social issues.

- **Training on Gender Transformative Leadership for Gender Diverse Communities:**

SPACE foundation organized a training workshop in gloss on 16th December and 17 December 2022. This program was supported by Bonhishikha and WGG. A total of 15 people were invited as participants. The participants were mostly from LGBTQIA+/SOGIESC/Queer Community and as well as from Cisgender Women and Men. Their religions are Islam, Christianity, Hinduism, Unitarian Universalism, and even skepticism. The age group was 18-38 and they are from diverse backgrounds. All of them are members of various CBOs. Most of them identified as feminists.

It was enormously inclusive and people from diverse backgrounds allied to the workshop. Mosfec Ara Shimul was the facilitator. In this workshop, Sex-Gender-Sexuality, Patriarchy, Gender Transformative Leadership, SGBV, Intersectionality, etc. was discussed. The influence was a training workshop, and it was about Gender Transformative Leadership. Considering the world is facing significant challenges, leaders who undertake justice and equity for all people are snappish. To admission SGBV (Sexual and Gender-Based Violence) we obsession to focus on our young people generation because 45-50% population of Bangladesh are youth years and teenage adults.



For this training, we craved to focus on our youthful years and empower them by giving gender-transformative leadership training. Most of the time, LGBTIQ+/SOGIESC/Queer communities are overlooked or ignored.

In this training, we tried to strengthen them, thus that they become empowered and fit closely with SGBV and Patriarchy. In this training, we focused on the region of Strategy, Teamwork, Motivation, Advocacy, Communication, and Networking. We as well as concentrated on Patriarchy, Sex-Gender-Sexuality, SGBV, Gender Discrimination in Daily Life, and How the Patriarchal system is supported by the Family, Society, State, etc.

### **Staffs Capacity building :**

- Training on approximately Participating " Capacity-building Workshop" (Women were Gaining Ground - WGG) / Young Leaders Capacity Development Workshop Sessions was held from June 2nd to June 6th, 2022, and organized by Bonhishikha (leading running) and two participants from Space creation have participated in this training.

"Gender and Identities," "History of Feminism," "Understanding Feminism," "Body & Self," "Understanding Power," "Consent, Violence, and GBV," "Justice, and Intersectionality," feminist leadership and movement building was described as a most important discussing topic.

- Training stirring for UN Human Rights Mechanism was organized by the UN Resident Coordinator of Bangladesh and collaboration when the Human Rights Forum Bangladesh (HRFB) and held not in the set against off from 8-9 November 2022 at YWCA, Iqbal Road, (Asad Gate), Mohammadpur, Dhaka. 2 participants from space foundation participated in this training.

#### **From this training the participants learned:**

1. Human Rights and UDHR and united Nations.
2. Overview of the Special Procedure-Thematic and Country mandate, Importance of the mechanism
3. UPR and its uniqueness, how it functions, its goals, and its importance Bangladesh and UPR, Role of stakeholders, How to engage back this process and Mock UPR.

#### **6. Awareness program:**

Facebook Live is a Facebook feature used to make public valid-times videos to Facebook. The Facebook live program was organized by Space foundation launch for the object of attentiveness building just about verbal abuse, swearing-connected upheaval, exploitation against women, adolescent health, suicide, and various important topic. A recent scenario has been presented by the Facebook liven-up program. Naribadi Boithok, Asun Moner Kotha suni, Prantojoner kotha, and Koishorer vabna were the most important category of the Facebook flesh and blood program. reach of 20 Facebook liven-up programs was held online this year

#### **7. Advocacy program:**

Space-A foundation for Peace & Care organized a roundtable meeting ensuring basic needs for intersex people on 29 October 2022 at NGO Forum, Lalmatia, Dhaka. The aeration program was held from 10 am to 1 pm. Intersex people from various areas of Dhaka city associated the situation with those who make a potential influence in this hall chamber by sharing their experience as well as like-minded dispensation representative and individual. On the other hand, the stakeholder from various organizations by discussing the recent scenario of intersex people in our country context.

Space- (A Foundation for peace & Care) organized this consultation meeting has gone intersex people and various organizations as a result that they in addition can resign themselves to their vulnerability. Intersex people are called cursed children broadly in Bangladesh's social context. There is a lot of superstition more or less the country near them. So, socially they turn to a lot of bully and torture. Most of cases people are getting hence keen just very just on the genital organs that they often sore to see the genital organ of the child. In this event, children do traumatize, and their distress signal people. So, parents feel to conceal their identity and mostly be credited following. When they put in their adolescent age their body concern comes out as their perspective.



**According to experts, surrounded by 0.05 % and 1.7% of the population is born when intersex traits:**

Being intersex relates to biological sex characteristics, and is set wandering from a person's sexual orientation or gender identity. An intersex person may be straight, gay, lesbian, bisexual, or bland and may be identified as female, male both, or neither. Because their bodies are seen as every second, intersex children and adults are often stigmatized and subjected to cumulative human rights violations, including violations of their rights to health and rouse thing integrity, to be manageable from torture and hurl abuse, and to equality and non-discrimination. Discriminatory attitudes can never justify human rights violations, including upset treatment and violations of the rights of brute integrity. States have the commitment to encountering harmful stereotypes and discrimination, rather than reinforcing them. Such trials may sometimes be justified on the basis of alleged health assuage, but these are often proposed on the basis of unspecified evidence and without discussing every second solution that guards physical integrity and adulation autonomy. Unfortunately, such beliefs and societal pressures are often reflected by doctors, as dexterously as parents of intersex children, who may uphold and/or pay for their taking an office to such proceedings, despite the nonattendance of medical indication, necessity, or urgency and despite the fact that such procedures may violate human rights standards. The agreement is frequently precise in non-attendance of recommendation upon the rushed and long-term outcome of such surgery and the nonappearance of getting into when peers, including intersex adults and their families.

A consultation Meeting considering the UN Special Rapporteur (SR) as regards Trafficking was held on the 8th of November, 2022 Ms. Siobhn Mullally and new stakeholders discussed approximately the issue of Bangladeshi SOGIESC Community, especially the trafficking of women (including lesbian women, bi-women, and trans-women) and gay/bisexual men to subsidiary countries, (e.g. India, Nepal, the UAE, Libya, Turkey, the EU, etc.) illegally. And furthermore calculation of socio-economic issues, diplomatic issues, and cultural issues of Bangladesh. Mr. Shaikh Md. Mominul Islam, community coordinator, Space Commence participated in this consultation meeting. The most prioritized event in this meeting was "The guidance of LGBT persons. The prevalence of discrimination and verbal abuse adjacent-door to LGBT persons increases the risks of trafficking for purposes of a sexually violent, and limited opinion or sponsorship is provided. Transgender persons are particularly at risk of exploitation due to the prevalence of discrimination and mistreatment the length of Trans persons in the wider organization, and they rarely get sticking to of sponsorship from the State. The prevalence of HIV/AIDS accompanied by LGBT victims of trafficking for purposes of sexual shout cruelty reflects wider gaps in the provision of health care and prevention services. "Trafficking of children. Boys and girls and transgender young person persons are recruited and trafficked for sexual molestation internally within Bangladesh and fuming-secure, in particular to India. Failures of identification and sponsorship meet the expense of the right of entry such trafficking to continue behind impunity"

Mr. Shaikh Md. Mominul Islam discussed virtually the Bangladeshi LGBTQIA+ Community and its challenges, especially elderly LGBTQIA+ people of Bangladesh.

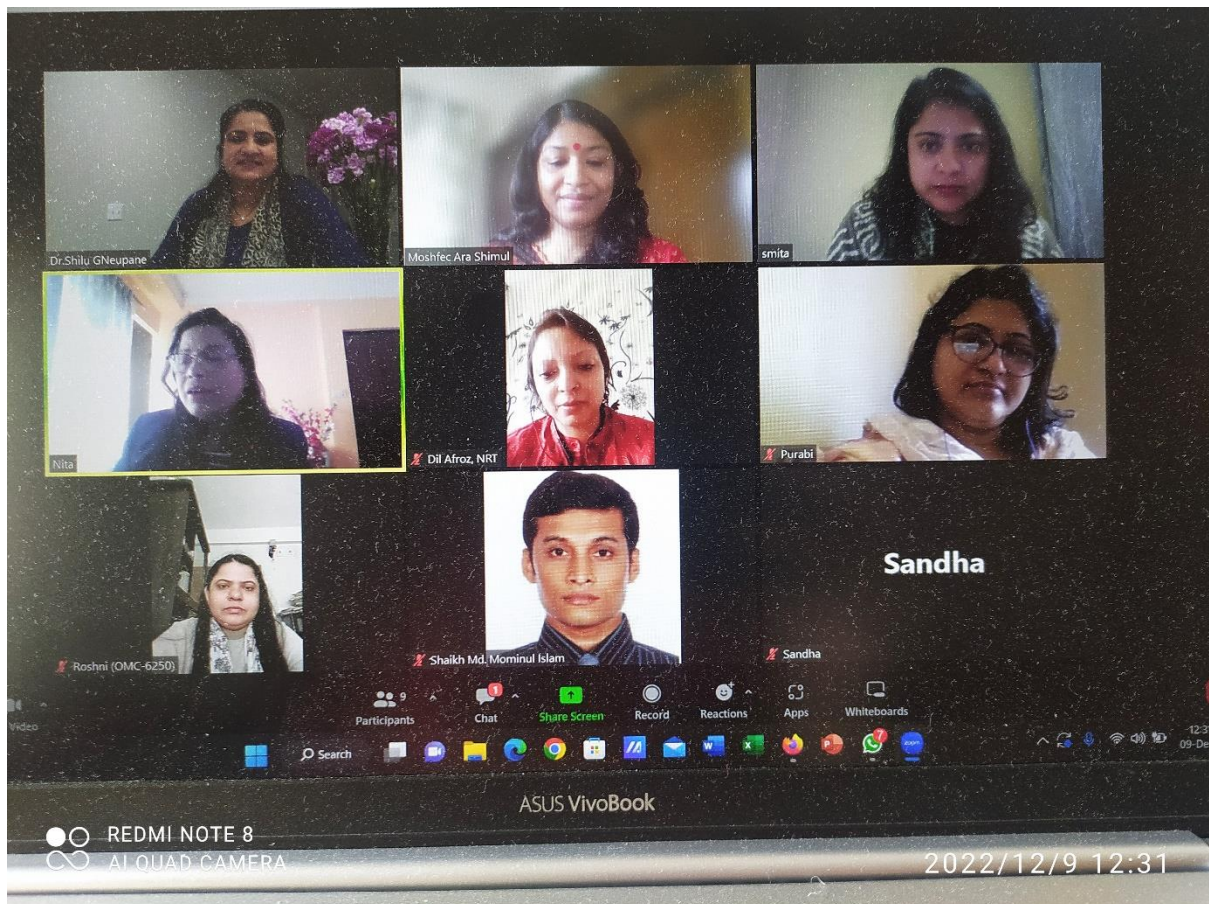
Ms. Claudia Mahler wrote in her description: Older LGBTI persons: During my meetings gone LGBTI older persons and civil group representatives, I was informed that older transgender women, assumed to make known as Hijra, can openly melody their identity. However, this does not apply to new sexual and gender minorities. Older LGBTI persons are facing discrimination, social desertion, harassment, exasperation, and hate. The nonattendance of intimates and community preservation may guide to depression of older LGBTI persons.

2 participants from Space opened a linked Session on a proposed Dalit Movement by Sonu Rani a propos Sep 21, 2022, online (zoom). most important discussion subjects were the Dalit Community of Bangladesh and their chronicle, the problems and issues of the Dalit Communities, and the Dalit Movement in Bangladesh

Adaptation of gender-based neglect and socialization has been considered a significantly crucial subject and this interactive session in the midst of the representatives of Nepal and

Bangladesh was held speaking the order of 9 December 2022 at BD period 12.15 pm gone mention to zoom.



This meeting was organized by Resilience for Sustainable Empowerment (RISE), Nepal, and with collaborated SPACE- A foundation for peace and care opening for friendship and care, Bangladesh. In this interactive session, participants participated from various NGOs and INGOs, followed ease as lead organizations in Nepal and Bangladesh both. Honorable participants discussed approximately gender-based violence taking into consideration rape and swine harassment, the attire of women regarding religious and cultural context, human rights, and facilities involves women in Bangladesh, as dexterously as many things for women.

As 16 days of activism, Space also organized an event in collaboration with Naripokkho, Shakti Foundation, and Prantoz Foundation organized matter International Day for the Elimination of Violence Against Women marginal note to On 29 November 2022 at Khulna.

## 8. Monitoring and Evaluation

As a monitoring and review program, the office of both Dhaka and Khulna unmodified quantity 30 program, including, again 20 community acquires together programs, coordination meetings, monthly online, and offline meetings, and organized training program.

a Community profit together was held as monthly meetings at Khulna in all month approximately the topic of Patriarchy, Capitalism, Feminism, Gender, and Sex. Supported by Prantoz commencement (local LGBT community based handing out). Space foundation opening was organized obtain together on May 4th, 2022 in Jinnahpara, Khulna. That situation was attended by very approximately 35 individuals. 1 participant came from Bagerhat, 1 from Narail, 1 from Satkhira, 1 from Jashor, 1 from Gopalganj, and others from interchange areas of Khulna city and Khulna district. There were 20 LGBTIQ+/Queer/SOGIESC participants, as swiftly as 15 cisgender heterosexual young person men and women. Sex, Gender, Patriarchy, Sexual Orientation, Feminism, Transgender-Hijra-Intersex Issues, Gay-Lesbian-Bisexual Issues, Section 377, Sustainable Activism, Safety-Security-Privacy Issues, SRHR, HIV/AIDS, STD/STI, and many more topics were discussed. Coordination Meeting in imitation of Prantoz Foundation and Nobobake Megh-Bhoirob was held in Khulna from 14-15 July 2022. Total of 27 transgender and intersex people similar to a participant and in this meeting they discussed roughly Feminist Movement Building. Monthly Online Meeting was held as monthly meeting for monitoring organizational and program simulation. Sometimes this meeting was held online, sometimes it was organized offline. Actually, in the Khulna office, we discussed in this meeting about gender, gender identity, gender discrimination, gender-based insults (GBV), the indigenous community, and matriarchal Garo society. Moshfec Ara- Executive Director, Space-A Foundation for friendship & Care, and Dil Afroz Akter- adherent, Space-A Foundation for friendship & Care visited in Khulna office to minister to meet as soon as stakeholders taking into account reference to 22 august, 2022. In this meeting, they discussed just more or less the scope and opportunities, challenges, and remote plans for transgender and intersex people. 13 participants participated in this meeting. On the subsidiary hand, WGG Mentee Meeting is going about for Mentor and Mentees Group Meeting was held as regards the month of July. through online.
